Lieutenant Colonel Gregory Field
U.S. Marine Corps

Lieutenant Colonel Field was born and raised in Reston, Virginia, prior to attending Miami University on a Marine-Option Naval ROTC scholarship. He graduated from Miami in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science, and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in the Marine Corps. He attended the Basic School in Quantico, Virginia in May 1996 and then attended Ground Supply Officer's Course in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina.



In April 1997, Lieutenant Colonel Field checked into 1st Supply Battalion, 1st Force Service Support Group in Camp Pendleton, California where he served as the Battalion Supply Officer and as the Supply Officer for Combat Service Support Detachment 19. In April 1999, he moved to Twenty-nine Palms, California and assumed the duties as Regimental Supply Officer for 7th Marines, 1st Marine Division. During this tour, he was promoted to the rank of Captain. Lieutenant Colonel Field returned to Camp Pendleton in July 2001 and assumed the duties as Officer-in-Charge of the Logistics Readiness Evaluation Team for 1st Marine Division. In October 2002, he stood up the Deployment Assistance Team to prepare units for the logistical and embarkation requirements for a rapid Division level deployment. In January 2003, he rejoined 7th Marines to be part of their Advance Arrival and Assembly Echelon (AAOE) and conducted a Maritime Preposition Squadron offload to reconstitute the Regimental Combat Team 7 (RCT-7) in Kuwait as part of Operation Enduring Freedom. Lieutenant Colonel Field remained RCT-7 Supply Officer through May 2003 as part of the assault into Iraq and Baghdad. In June 2003, he returned to the states and moved to Columbia, Missouri where he assumed the duties as Marine Officer Instructor (MOI) and Operations Officer for Naval ROTC unit, University of Missouri. During this tour, he completed a Masters of Arts in Education from Central Michigan University, which he began in Camp Pendleton prior to the deployment. Lieutenant Colonel Field moved to MCAS Miramar in May 2006 to be the S-4 and Supply Officer for Marine Air Control Group 38 (MACG-38). During this tour, he was promoted to Major and deployed twice to Operation Iraqi Freedom, in 2006 and 2008. In September 2009, Lieutenant Colonel Field moved to the Washington D.C. area to serve as the representative for Marine Corps and Irregular Warfare programs on the Navy Staff in the Pentagon. During this tour, he was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel. In July 2013, he assumed the duties as Director, Fleet Support Division and Commanding Officer of Headquarters Company West, LOGCOM in Barstow, California. Lieutenant Colonel Field has assumed the duties as Inspector Instructor of Combat Logistics Battalion 453 in Aurora, Colorado in May 2015.

Lieutenant Colonel Field is married to Andrea Barlow of Stoke-on-Trent, United Kingdom. He has primary custody of his son, Adam Jacob Field, age 14, from a previous marriage, and a two year old girl, Gatsby Barlow Field.

His personal awards include a Meritorious Service Medal with a gold star, Navy Commendation Medal with three gold stars, a Navy Achievement Medal, and a Combat Action Ribbon.
